Against the approach of Durão Barroso's European Commission and against the Sócrates Government White Paper on Labour Relations:

- allowing the employers to freely dismiss workers;
- cancelling the existing limit to daily working hours!

BECAUSE it promotes the weakening of the right to work and to job security!

BECAUSE, although Portugal is the EU-15 country with the lowest salaries (successive governments made promises of approximation to the EU salary averages) they want to go even further in:

- reducing salaries, making labour become cheaper, increasing exploitation and capital profits;
- destroying collective bargaining and curbing the role and action of the trade unions;
- conceding extended power (never checked) to companies and employers!

BECAUSE they simply wish to introduce flexibility and no security at all!

- FOSTER COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AND ABANDONING THE PROVISION OF VOID COLLECTIVE AGREEMENTS
- INCREASE SALARIES
